For the Commemoration of the First Year After the Death of the Hutuktu Changchia A Ritual of Bhaisajya-gurn-vaiduryaprabhasa, The Buddha of Medicine, Was Held And his Sariras Were Bestowed

Maha Theras Were Invited to Recite Sutras and Dharanis for Forty-nine Days

High Government Officials Came to Offer Incense

(Taipei) One year has passed since the passing away of the Hutuktu Changchia. A forty-nine day ritual of Bhaisajya-guru-vaiduryaprabhasa, the Buddha of Medicine, was held for the commemoration at Shentao Temple. Maha Theras were invited to recite the Sutras at the esoteric altar and Dharnis were recited by the Hutuktu Kanjurwa at the exoteric altar Sariras, and Relics were bestowed to the disciples. Many high government officials came to offer incense at the altar.

For the Commemoration of the Memory of the Ven. Chihchon, His Writings Were Printed

(Taipei) For the commemoration of death of the Ven. Chihchon, the Ven. Paisheng of Shihpu Temple and the Ven. Taoyuan of Haihui Temple suggested that a meeting be held and that his remaining writings be printed.
